There are many changes coming for both you and your child. There are resources to help you make adjustments together along the way.



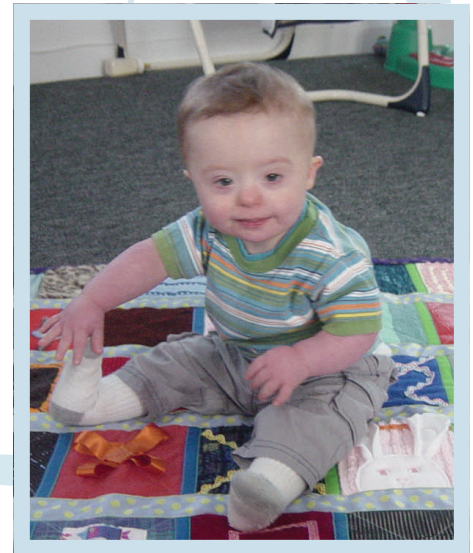
